



Day 01: Arrive Nairobi Arrive in Nairobi and transfer to your hotel. Meet your Tour Director and later this evening your fellow travellers, as you begin your East Africa journey.

Day O2: Nairobi, Ngorongoro CraterTake a flight via Kilimanjaro to Lake
Manyara in Tanzania and travel by
4WD vehicles to your lodge. Enjoy time
at leisure before dinner. **BLD**

Three Nights: Ngorongoro, Acacia Farm Lodge.

Day 03: Ngorongoro Crater

Today at the crater, you will stop for a picnic lunch, giving you time to take in the surrounds. Often referred to as 'Africa's Garden of Eden' and one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa, the crater's high walls provide a natural enclosure to vast numbers of wildebeest, zebras, gazelles and lions, so make sure you have your camera ready to capture the abundant wildlife. **BLD**

Day 04: Ngorongoro Crater, Lake Manyara

Today, you will be given the opportunity to visit a local school. Afterwards, you will venture to a Maasai village and enjoy a traditional lunch before a game drive through Lake Manyara National Park. **BLD**

Day 05: Serengeti National Park

At Olduvai Gorge, also known as the 'Cradle of Mankind', enjoy a fascinating private tour in which you will see some of the earliest evidence of our first human ancestors who existed in the area over one million years ago. Take in the spectacular, expansive views and keep an eye out for wildlife as you travel to Serengeti National Park. **BLD**

Three Nights: Serengeti National Park, Melia Serengeti Lodge.

Day 06: Serengeti National Park

Experience the Serengeti's wild side with a game drive at sunrise, where you'll encounter an awe-inspiring array of animals. Return to your plush lodge for some well-earned relaxation time, soaking up the stunning views and perhaps taking a refreshing dip in the infinity pool while basking in the African sun. Later, witness the savannah come alive on a sunset game drive and watch in wonder as the animals prepare for nightfall. Finish the day in style with a delectable dinner at your luxurious lodge. **BLD**

Day 07: Serengeti National Park, Masai Mara A third day in the national park offers the opportunity to spot any animals that you may have missed on game drives yesterday. BLD

Day 08: Serengeti National Park,

Spend the early afternoon relaxing at the camp, perhaps watching resident hippos in the Mara River from your deck. Day 10: Masai Mara Explore the Masai Mara Reserve with a full-day game drive and a picnic lunch – an ideal opportunity for further wildlife viewing in the glorious African wilderness. This evening, a traditional bush dinner is served within the incredible setting of the Masai Mara. BLD

Day 11: Masai Mara, Nairobi This morning you will say goodbye to the Masai Mara, take a flight to Nairobi and savour a final lunch at Karen Blixen Coffee Gardens. At the day's end, enjoy a private performance by the Kenyan Boys Choir, with a farewell toast. BL

Stay: Nairobi, Villa Rosa Kempinski.
